Do You Have Experience in Nova Scotia Schools?

- Are you a retired teacher or administrator?
- Are you interested in mentoring the next generation of teachers?

Job Requirements:

- 1. **Experience:** Retired teacher or administrator
- 2. **Availability:** Supervise preservice teachers in their school
- 3. Mentorship: Be a supportive mentor to preservice teachers
- 4. **Reporting:** Submit reports according to a predetermined timeline
- 5. **Knowledge:** Familiarity with NS Teaching Standards and Culturally Relevant Pedagogy and the importance of relationship building with students

Responsibilities:

- **Mentor Preservice Teachers:** Support and guide them through their practicum experiences together with their Associate Teacher
- **Represent MSVU:** Act as a liaison with the Associate Teacher and school admin
- **Consult:** Work with the Associate Teacher regarding the preservice teacher's progress
- **Observation:** Observe preservice teachers 5 times during their Practicum, providing written and oral feedback.
- **Coordinate Visits:** Arrange visitation dates and times with preservice teachers and Associate Teachers
- **Reflection Submission:** Arrange dates for submission of reflections by preservice teachers
- **Report Concerns:** Notify the BEd Practicum coordinator of any concerns

Visitation Schedule:

- 20-Month Program:
 - Year 1: 1 week in November, 1 week in February, and during the teaching block in April-May
 - Year 2: 1 week in November, and during the main teaching block January-April
- 14-Month Program:
 - Mid-December, Mid-January, and main teaching block April-June

Compensation:

- **Position:** Paid contract for fall, winter, and spring sessions
- Travel: Paid at the rate of 51 cents/km
